## Moss Trust funds Pacesetters' summer adventures program

Western Carolina Pacesetters recently received a \$5,000 donation from the Fred A. Moss Charity Trust to fund Pacesetters 2006 Summer Adventures. The Moss Trust has supported Pacesetter programs for at risk and under served youth since 1999 and helped over 3,000 local youth experience high adventure activities at no cost to them or their families.

Pacesetters' serves youth in the five most western counties of North Carolina: Clay, Cherokee, Macon, Graham, and Swain. In addition to providing programs for alternative schools, court involved youth, and after school programs such as Power Partners, SOS, and Gear UP, Pacesetters operates a 50 acre adventure center located in Marble that welcomes a wide range of youth groups and programs. The Adventure Center features a sixty foot Alpine Tower II with a Giant Swing, a fifty five foot climbing and rappelling tower named the Great Wall of Opportunity, a junior golf instructional facility complete with driving range and 2500 square foot artificial putting green, a seven element team development course, volleyball, fishing along the Valley River, and a classroom building housing a kitchenette and handicap accessible bathroom.

The Moss Charity Trust was established in 1964 by the late Dr. Moss who was born in Hayesville, NC in 1893. Dr. Moss achieved international recognition for his work in the field of psychology and numerous books published under his name. Dr. Moss was instrumental in establishing the Moss Memorial Library in Hayesville which is named after him. The Moss Charity Trust helps a number of area nonprofits such as Pacesetters and is charged

"to use and expend the net income of the trust property solely for religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational purposes...."

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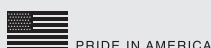
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
